Advent 1C Psalm 89:6, 14–16, 18; antiphon: Zechariah 9:9b, alt.

P Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation.

C Who in the skies can be compared to the Lord? Who among the heavenly beings is like the Lord?

P Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; steadfast love and faithfulness go before you.

C Blessed are the people who know the festal shout, who walk, O Lord, in the light of your face,
