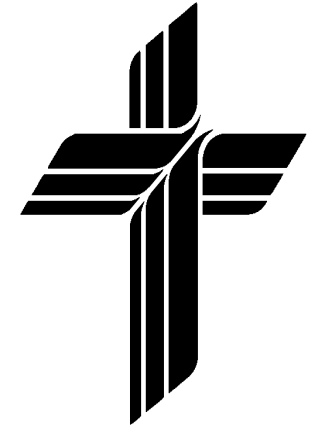

***As We Gather...** We approach the end of the church year in the next couple weeks. Today and next Sunday we examine the themes of the return of Christ. Jesus warns His disciples of the signs of the times. Many of these signs in this passage in Luke were fulfilled when Jerusalem fell to the Romans in 70 A.D. But that destruction serves as a template for the upheaval that is coming when Jesus comes again to judge the living and the dead. Nonetheless, for us Christians, Jesus said, "Now when these things begin to take place, straighten up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."
